Daniel Boone Days is a two-day festival scheduled for Friday and Saturday, September 4 and 5, 2009, in Boone, NC. The festival includes a symposium on Daniel Boone with bestselling author Robert Morgan, Fess Parker wine dinners, a Guinness World Record attempt and a music and culture festival at Horn in the West. For the festival at Horn in the West, the creators of Daniel Boone Days are looking for regional arts and crafts vendors to setup around the amphitheater. More than 2,000 attendees are expected for the festival. Because the Horn in the West Board is in charge of concessions, *no food vendors are allowed to apply*, but there are roughly 20 spaces for arts and craft vendors inside the gates that are placed in the middle of the main thoroughfares of the festival.
